- Always affirm in public (validation is the key)
- Be clear, consistent and fair (treat everyone with respect)
- Play to strengths and cooperation (each of us has gifts to bring, be creative)
- If possible, problem solve as a group
- Communicate, communicate, communicate (camp is a small town)
